Independent Examiner's Report to the PCC of St James, Cambridge

This report on the accounts of the PCC for the year ended 31st December 2020 is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 ("the Regulations") and section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 ("the Act").

Respective responsibilities of the PCC and the examiner

Basis of the independent examiner's report

The financial statements of the PCC have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts and Payments basis. Receipts include income as received and expenditure when irrevocably paid. The accounts include all monetary transactions, assets and liabilities for which the PCC can be held responsible.

General funds represent the funds of the PCC that are not subject to any special restrictions regarding their use and are available for application to the general purposes of the PCC. They include any funds designated for specific purposes by the PCC.

Restricted purpose funds are those funds which have been given on trust for a specified purpose and may only be applied for that purpose.

4 Direct Debit Rebate & Deanery contribution

The Diocese of Ely offers an incentive scheme to PCCs to encourage payment of Parish Shares by monthly direct debit. An allowance of 2.5% of the amount paid by direct debit is rebated to the PCC by offset against the Parish Share for the following year. It follows that the rebate shown in 2020 is 2.5% of the 2019 net Parish Share.

The Deanery contribution rebate is a rebate of South Cambridge Deanery Parish Share based on total Deanery contributions.

12 Focus Christian Education Fund

On the closure of the Focus Christian Institute (FCI) in 2007, the trustees of FCI came to an agreement with St James' Church PCC that the remaining funds of FCI should be transferred to St James' Church PCC but be held for the purposes of Christian Education.
