

## Today's Psalm is: Psalm 40.1-12

1 I waited patiently / for the / Lord;  
he inclined to / me and / heard my / cry.  
2 He brought me out of the roaring pit,  
out of the / mire and / clay;  
he set my feet upon a rock and / made my / footing / sure.  
3 He has put a new song in my mouth,  
a song of / praise to our / God;  
many shall see and fear  
and / put their / trust in the / Lord.  
4 Blessed is the one who / trusts in the / Lord,  
who does not turn to the / proud that / follow a / lie.  
5 Great are the wonders you have done, O Lord my God.  
How great / your de/signs for us!  
There is none that / can be com/pared with / you.  
6 If I were to pro/claim them and / tell of them  
they would be more than I am / able / to ex/press.  
7 Sacrifice and offering you do / not de/sire  
but my / ears / you have / opened;  
8 burnt offering and sacrifice for sin you have / not re/quired;  
then / said I: / Lo, I / come.  
9 'In the scroll of the book it is written of me  
that I should do your will, / O my / God;  
I delight to do it: your / law is with/in my / heart'.  
10 I have declared your righteousness in the great / congre/gation;  
behold, I did not restrain my lips,  
and / that, O / Lord, you / know.  
11 Your righteousness I have not hidden / in my / heart;  
I have spoken of your / faithfulness and / your sal/vation;  
11a I have not concealed your loving/kindness and / truth  
from the / great / congre/gation.  
12 Do not withhold your compassion from / me, O / Lord;  
let your love and your / faithfulness / always pre/serve me.
