10 You brought us / into the / snare;  
you laid heavy / burdens up/on our / backs.  
11 You let enemies ride over our heads;  
we went through / fire and / water;  
but you brought us out / into a / place of / liberty.  
12 I will come into your house with burnt offerings  
and will / pay you my / vows,  
which my lips uttered  
and my mouth promised / when I / was in / trouble.  
13 I will offer you fat burnt sacrifices with the / smoke of / rams;  
I will / sacrifice / oxen and / goats.  
14 Come and listen, all / you who fear / God,  
and I will tell you what / he has / done for my / soul.
